- Additional resources, where needed, to help you fundraise and engage your wider community.



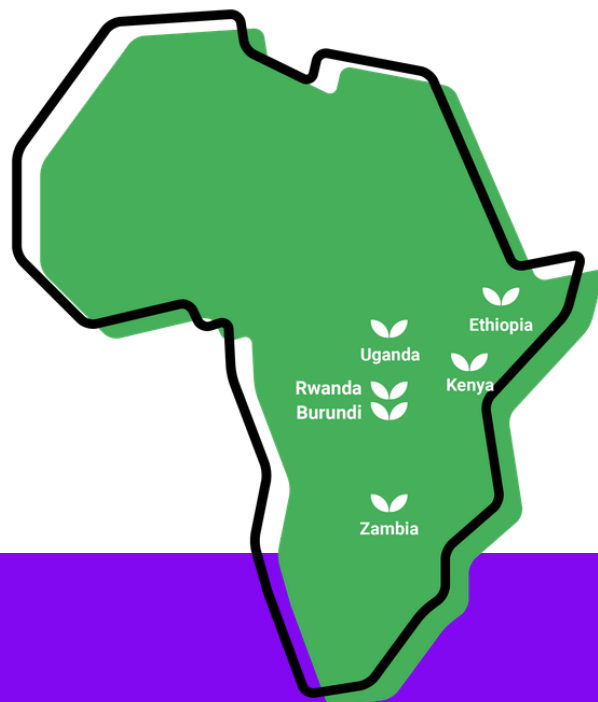

We support families in east Africa so they can fight hunger and the climate crisis. Families then share what they know and have with their communities. For every family we work with, another three will benefit, creating a ripple effect across rural Africa!

Where we work alongside families



The Challenge

Rural Africa is rich with opportunity, with resourceful people and land which can produce enough food to feed the continent and beyond.

But families face poverty that is extreme, cruel, and worst of all – unnecessary. The knowledge and skills needed for farmers to grow and sell effectively are often lost or haven't adapted to changed conditions. Climate crisis, conflict and pandemic threaten to push millions back into extreme poverty. [Read more](#) about the climate crisis.

Our practical programmes are targeted where the need is greatest, with the knowledge and benefits shared by everyone.

Your Eco-Mission Partnership:

Focus: sustainable farming including tree planting, soil health and growing climate resilient crops plus gender and social inclusion and enterprise development.

Location: Rural communities in Kenya, Zambia, Burundi, Ethiopia, Rwanda and Uganda.

Number of people reached in 24-25: 1.1 million

Cost: £20 per household, per year.

Duration: Projects run for 3-5 years to ensure families are resilient and won't slip back in to poverty

Ripple Effect's local staff in Africa help families develop a shared vision for their home which helps to empower women and girls. Through facilitated activities, we help the family work out how best to share the workload and decision-making to achieve their vision.

Grow more!

We train families in using up-to-date and traditional approaches to farming. Families learn to build productive farms and adapt to the effects of the climate crisis. And ultimately their farms will have a climate-positive impact!

Sell more!

Once families are eating well and earning enough to send their children to school, we encourage them to think bigger, beyond just food security. Families learn to set up small businesses.
