

# Ripple Effect Prize Draw - Terms & Conditions

## 1. Promoter

The promoter of this prize draw is Ripple Effect International, a registered charity in England and Wales (299717) and Scotland (SC049792), whose registered address is Runway East, Kings Court, Parsonage Lane, Bath, BA1 1ER.

This draw is operated as a prize draw, not a lottery, under the Gambling Act 2005.

## 2. Eligibility

- Entrants must be 18 years or over.
- Employees of the promoter directly involved in the management of the prize draw are not eligible to enter the prize draw.
- Entries must be made in the entrant's own name.

## 3. How to Enter

- Entry can be made online or by post.
- Online entries are £5.
- Each £5 purchase is classed as one entry into the prize draw.
- Free entry is available by post.
- To enter by post, send your full name, email address and telephone number on a postcard or in an envelope to: Ripple Effect, Runway East, Kings Court, Parsonage Lane, Bath, BA1 1ER.
- Postal entries must be received by the closing date.
- Each valid postal entry will be entered into the draw and treated equally to paid entries.
- Only one entry per envelope/postcard.
- There is no maximum limit on the number of entries that may be submitted either online or by post
- Gift Aid cannot be claimed on payments made in connection with this prize draw.
- Entry fees are non-refundable, except where the prize draw is cancelled.
- No purchase or donation is necessary to enter or win.

## 4. Closing Date

- All entries must be received by 11:59pm BST on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026

- Any entries received after this time and date will not be entered into the draw.

## 5. Prize

- The prize comprises a two-night bed and breakfast stay for two people at The Bull Inn in Totnes, a lunch for two at The Bull, a dinner for two at The Albatross Pizza Shop and a meal for two (brunch, lunch or dinner) at the Riverford Field Kitchen.
- Travel to and from the venues is not included unless otherwise stated.
- The approximate retail value is £600.
- No cash alternative or transfer to an alternative prize is possible.
- The prize is subject to availability and must be booked in advance.
- The prize must be used by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2026. No extension beyond this date is possible.

## 6. Winner Selection

- The winner will be selected at random using a computer-generated process from all eligible entries.
- The result will be recorded and saved within Ripple Effect systems.
- Entries that are incomplete, illegible or do not comply with these Terms & Conditions may be disqualified.

- The winner will be contacted within 5 days via email and/or telephone.
- If the winner does not respond within 7 days to claim their prize, Ripple Effect reserves the right to select another winner.
- Winner details may be shared with the companies providing the prizes to complete fulfilment of the prizes. Data will not be used for marketing purposes by the prize providers unless explicit consent has been given.

## 8. Data Protection
